There has been a Mid-career and Senior Consortium on the program of OBTC since at least 2009. It has annually been attended by about a dozen to two dozen individuals, most of whom will comment how useful it is to them. Given the current emphasis on newer faculty (e.g. the DI and EEI), this consortium offers added value to more senior participants. A similar proposal for a Consortium will be made to the Eastern Academy of Management annual conference as has been done each year since at least 2008.
